4.1.1 Proposal for the Academic Calendar Session I 2024/2025

Meeting **AGREED**

- (i) to approve the following matters:
 - a. for the dates of January 27, 28, and 31, 2025 to be designated as University Holidays in conjunction with the Chinese New Year.
 - b. the lecture dates on April 3 and 4, 2025 to be conducted according to the needs of each faculty/program.
 - c. an additional one (1) day of compensatory leave* for students in conjunction with major festivals in Malaysia if the festival dates fall during the lecture/examination week as follows:
 - Deepavali Day – October 31, 2024 (Thursday), additional compensatory leave – November 1, 2024 (Friday)
 - Thaipusam Day – February 11, 2025 (Tuesday) as Compensatory Leave for Christmas Day – December 25, 2024 (Wednesday), additional compensatory leave – December 26, 2024 (Thursday)
 - Aidilfitri Day – March 31 & April 1, 2025 (Monday & Tuesday), additional compensatory leave – April 2, 2025. (Friday)
